Dear Parents/Guardians:

As our 2018-2019 school year comes to an end, we begin the preparations for the 2019-2020 school year. Little Flower Catholic School will implement a change in the uniform guidelines for the 2019-2020 school year. All students are required to wear the designated Little Flower Catholic School uniform. Uniforms may be purchased through Zoghby's Uniform and Lost Bay Designs.

Changes to the uniform guidelines are as follows:

- In addition to the designated uniform, Middle School will wear a dress uniform to be worn on Wednesdays to Mass and for any formal school event off campus (this cost will be included in tuition).
- Girls in 4th - 8th grade will wear the plaid skirt (khaki pants and shorts will no longer be an option).
- Hoodies, of any color, will not be worn on campus.
- All students will wear a Sperry-type boat shoe, with the exception of PE days, any athletic shoe will be allowed on those days.

Lastly, student attire must promote human dignity, cleanliness, and good health. Uniforms must be clean, wrinkle-free and in good condition. Uniforms must fit correctly, be worn appropriately and be changed as needed to accommodate the growth of the student throughout the school year.
