Uniform/Dress Code Guidelines 2019-2020

All students at Little Flower Catholic School must wear designated uniforms (specific articles listed in Uniform Requirements document) while at school during regular school hours and at most school sponsored events (such as field trips). Uniforms must be clean, wrinkle-free, and in good condition. Uniforms must fit correctly, be worn appropriately and be changed as needed to accommodate the growth of the student throughout the school year.

All uniforms must be purchased from the approved vendors: Zoghby's Uniforms and Lost Bay Design. They must be purchased according to the LFCS approved list.

MASS UNIFORMS: Mass Uniforms (as outlined below) shall be worn every Wednesday, on other designated mass days and field trips unless otherwise directed. All uniforms should be worn with brown/khaki boat shoe.

- Girls: K5 through 3rd Grade: white peter pan blouse and plaid jumper.
- Girls: 4th-5th Grades: white LFCS polo shirt and LFCS plaid skirt
- Girls: MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS UNIFORM (6th through 8th Grades): black blazer, khaki skirt, white button up oxford shirt (long or short sleeve) with tie.
- Boys: K5 through 5th Grade: khaki shorts or pants with belt and a white LFCS polo shirt.
- Boys: MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS UNIFORM (6th through 8th Grades): black blazer, khaki pant with belt, white button up oxford shirt (long or short sleeve) with LFCS black and red stripe tie or bow tie.

P.E. UNIFORMS

- Grades Pre-K-8th shall wear the specified P.E. uniform.
- P.E. shorts and shirts must be purchased at Lost Bay Designs.

DAILY DRESS CODE GUIDELINES TOPS (shirts, blouses)

- All shirts (K-5: red or white LFCS polo; Grades 6-8 red, white, or black LFCS polo) must be long enough to stay tucked in at all times.
- All buttons on polo shirts must be buttoned except the top button.
- Long sleeve shirts may NOT be worn under short sleeve shirts.
- Undershirts must be completely plain white, sleeveless or short-sleeved, and may not show.

BOTTOMS & DRESSES (pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers)

- The length of girls' shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers and dresses must be appropriate for school and church (at least to finger-tips with arms relaxed at sides or longer). All girls in grades 4-8 must wear a skirt; no shorts or pant option.
- Girls must wear privacy shorts under skirts, jumpers and dresses.
- The length of boys' shorts must be no shorter than 2" above the knee and not longer than the knee.
- Waists must not be rolled up to shorten garment.
- Hems of long pants may not pool on the floor or be rolled up. All pants must be appropriately hemmed.

BELTS

- Students in Grades 3 – 8 must wear belts with all garments with belt loops.

SHOES / FOOTWEAR

- Shoes must be khaki/brown boat shoe for both regular and mass uniform. Any type of athletic shoe with a rubber sole may be worn on PE Days.
- Socks, leggings or tights must be worn at all times.
- Socks, leggings and tights must be solid white or black. Small discrete logos may be permitted on a case by case basis. (Example: small Nike swoosh or small Adidas logo or small Under Armour logo)

OUTERWEAR

- If the temperature is above 32 degrees Fahrenheit, students may only wear official uniform outerwear (sweaters, jackets, vests, coats, sweatshirts, fleece)
- If the temperature is 32 degrees Fahrenheit or below, students may wear unofficial outerwear when outside only.
- Hats (no ball caps), gloves and scarves may be worn as needed when outside only.
- Hoodies of any kind are NEVER permitted.

HAIR

- All students' hairstyles must be neat and groomed away from the face.
- Color enhancing is permitted only when done in naturally occurring hair colors.
- No feathers or hair wraps will be permitted.
- Only simple school plaid or simple solid colored white, red, or black headbands are permitted. (School plaid headbands are available through Zoghby's).

JEWELRY, MAKE-UP AND PERSONAL CARE

- No visible piercings, other than ears. Only one earring may be worn in each ear.
- No permanent tattoos may be visibly worn by any student.
- Drawings on visible parts of the body are not permitted.
- Girls may not wear unnatural or glitter make-up.

DESIGNATED DRESS DAYS (All dress code standards still apply.)

Jeans Day – All students in good academic and behavior standing will be permitted to wear any LFCS activity T-shirt with jeans on the last Friday of every month.

Field Trips – All students must wear the Mass Uniform on field trips unless otherwise directed.

Special Dress Days – Certain non-uniform items may be worn on special days as scheduled and will be announced in advance (e.g. spirit days, holiday dress, etc.)
